What will your child be learning about this half term?

In **English** we will be reading ‘Made by Raffi’, ‘Ruby’s Worry’, ‘Little Tree’ and Poetry. We will be writing in different genres including descriptions, instructions, and poems and will be focusing on learning the following grammar rules: Capital Letters, Full stops and finger spaces.

In **maths** we will be focusing on recognising numbers to 20, counting backwards and forwards to 20, reading numbers as words, identifying one more and one less than a number and learning our number bonds to 10.

Our topic in **science** is ‘Animals including Humans’.

Our **learning journey** this half term is ‘How do I become Independent?’

We will be focusing on learning skills in **history** such as talking about our past, and how we changed over time.

In **music** our focus will be on listening and appraising to different genres, and exploring instruments such as claves.

In **PE** we will be doing ball skills and dance.

In **Religion and Worldviews** we will be learning about belonging and looking at Christianity, Judaism and Islam.
