Please reinforce the Makaton signs learnt so far, and don't forget to add any photos to Tapestry!


Top Tips for Talking:

Talk to your child when playing together: explain what you are doing and think aloud.

Get into their zone: talk about what they are looking at or playing with – they will learn new language faster this way, be descriptive and adventurous with language.
