

# Year 5 Newsletter Autumn Two 2023


## Year 5's learning experiences from Autumn One

Dahl – Children had fun listening to the poetry performed by the poet Paul Lyall. They enjoyed participating with the poems and were able to pose questions for the poet to answer.

#### What will your child be learning about this half term?

In English we will be reading Nevermoor, The Distance Between Me & the Cherry Tree and Voices in the Park. We will be writing in different genres including recounts, narrative from a different perspective, emotive letter and setting description. We will be focusing on learning the following grammar rules - descriptive techniques, fronted adverbials, figurative language and cohesive devices.

In maths we will be focusing on properties of number, fractions, decimals, place value (rounding) and area & perimeter. Our topic in science is 'Properties and Changing Materials'. Children will be learning about and exploring properties of a variety of materials and their uses. They will learn to use scientific vocabulary in planning and carrying out investigations to prove or disprove their predictions.

Our learning quest this half term is, 'What do we have the Victorians to thank for?'

We will be focusing on learning skills in history. We will seek out and analyse a wide range of evidence in order to justify claims about the past and to understand how Victorian Britain changed during the industrial

revolution.

In art we will be learning how to design and create our own wallpaper using printing techniques inspired by the famous artist William Morris.

In music our focus will be on singing, listening to and appraising music from a range of composers and musicians both independently and collaboratively.

In PE we will be doing netball and gymnastics.

In RE we will be learning about Christianity – The Tue Meaning of Christmas.

In French we will learn to listen attentively to spoken French and show understanding by using vocabulary for related body parts.
