Or Research old British currency and write some World War 2 maths money problems.	Write a diary entry of an evacuee. Or Write a poem about the impacts of conflict on society.	Discuss the role of different leaders during World War 2. Who do you think was most influential? Was this in a positive or negative way? Or Talk to relatives about members of your family who were alive during World War 2. Share stories in class.	Create your own air raid shelter. Or Write a song which would boost morale during a time of conflict. Or Find a World War 2 recipe online and have a go at making it yourself.	Teach an adult about the role of women during World War 2. Decide whether the war could have been won without them. And Teach someone the importance of respect and tolerance as opposed to power and conflict.	Visit a cenotaph in the local area. Notice what is written on it? How does it make you feel?	Investigate how a radar works and how it helped in World War 2.	Listen to a speech by Winston Churchill during WW2.
